

## MINUTES OF AWLISCOMBE PARISH COUNCIL MEETING

Monday 15<sup>th</sup> October 2018

1. **Apologies for absence:** The Police, District Councillor P. Skinner

2. **Police Report:** P.C.S.O. Darren England had sent a report saying that there had been 3 crimes in the parish between 3<sup>rd</sup> September – 15<sup>th</sup> October 1.) Burglary dwelling and theft - no violence - Property entered whilst person away. Items taken (Awliscombe)

2.) Burglary other than dwelling with intent to steal – Items taken from out building. ( Awliscombe )

3.) Drive motor vehicle when alcohol level above limit – Person located following police log (Weston). The Clerk had contacted the PCSO to ask for some more information regarding the crimes that had been reported over the last few months but unfortunately, they are unable to divulge further info due to ongoing cases that are being looked into.

3. **Items from County/District Councillors** Cllr Chubb reported that a huge amount of money had been spent on the roads to repair and upgrade but that Skanska who took over from SWH would be under scrutiny to make sure they are carrying out the works successfully. The budget will be set in the next couple of months both for DCC and EDDC and extra money would be sought for social care and young children.

**18/1429/FUL – Mr. D. Dymond, Barns at Meadow View, Awliscombe** Works to barns to facilitate permitted change of use to hotel including Class R conversion of barns from agricultural to use class C1. **Awaiting decision.**

**18/1484/FUL – Mr T. Rosewell, New Park Farm, Awliscombe** – Roofing over of two existing silage clamps. – **Permission granted**

**18/1304/FUL – Mr J Vince, 12 Nap View, Awliscombe** - Construction of single storey rear extension. – **Permission granted.**

**18/0704/FUL Mr L. Brindeau – Redacres, Awliscombe** - Construction of 3 bay garage and workshop/store, relocation of greenhouse, construction of new stone wall and new retaining wall – **Permission granted**
