1. Apologies for absence: The Police

2. Police Report: No report sent.

3. Items from County/District Councillors Cllr Skinner introduced Cllr David Key and Cllr Colin Brown who are the present time District Councillors for the Dunkeswell and Otter Vale Ward's and this is where Awliscombe will fall under after the Local Elections next year. Cllr Skinner will no longer be our Ward member as he is taking back Talaton along with Payhembury and Broadhembury. Cllr Keys was interested in the issues that Awliscombe were facing and The Chairman informed him of the problems we are having with Affordable Housing and Internet. Cllr Skinner said that he was hoping to arrange a visit to the Science Park for the Parish Council in the new year.

18/1429/FUL – Mr. D. Dymond, Barns at Meadow View, Awliscombe Works to barns to facilitate permitted change of use to hotel including Class R conversion of barns from agricultural to use class C1. **Awaiting decision.**

Parishioners Questions – Steve Brownridge reported that the gazebos that had been purchased through the parishes together money had been broken and asked who was responsible for repairing them as he wished to borrow them at a later date. Cllr Wright said to apply to Honiton Town Council as they had a contact number.

9. Highways: The Clerk reported that she had been in contact with Phillip Morgan from Highways who had said that the railings at Sunnyside would not be replaced as they are not a safety issue and Cllr Summers said that he would remove them. Also, the ones at Trafalgar bridge in Weston were also not a safety concern and would not be replaced.

10. Update on Defibrillator: A letter had been written to the Parish Hall Committee regarding the Defibrillator and they were all in agreement that this could be placed on the outside wall next to the changing rooms. The Clerk was disappointed to find out that there had been a hold up with the ordering of the defibs because a VAT issue but had told Honiton League of Friends that the parish council would be able to claim this back and all councilors were happy to pay the extra £200 to allow the purchase to go ahead.
